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**ACT SUMMARY**

- Authorizes the conveyance of state-owned real estate located in Ottawa County from the Ohio Department of Transportation to Paul Hemrick, Jr.

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**CONTENT AND OPERATION**

The act authorizes the Governor to execute a deed in the name of the state conveying to Paul Hemrick, Jr., and his heirs and assigns, all of the state's right, title, and interest in real estate located in Ottawa County. The conveyance involves a parcel of land consisting of approximately 4.3 acres. (Section 1.)

The consideration for the conveyance is the purchase price of \$6,900 (Section 2).

Upon the payment of the purchase price by Paul Hemrick, Jr., the act provides for following the procedures in codified law (sec. 5301.13) for preparation, execution, and recording of a deed to the real estate (Section 3).

Paul Hemrick, Jr., must pay the costs of the conveyance (Section 4).

The act expires on March 10, 2001.
