BILL SUMMARY

- Requires schools to devote at least one hour on Veterans' Day to an observance that conveys the meaning and significance of that day.

CONTENT AND OPERATION

The bill

(sec. 3313.602)

Under the bill, each school board must require all district schools to devote at least one hour on Veterans' Day to an observance that conveys the meaning and significance of that day. The board is to determine the specific activities that constitute the observance in each school after consultation with the school's administrators.

If school is not scheduled to be in session on Veterans' Day, the observance is to be held on the school day immediately preceding Veterans' Day.
