**BILL SUMMARY**

- Requires schools to devote time on Veterans' Day to an observance that conveys the meaning and significance of that day.

---

**CONTENT AND OPERATION**

Under the bill, each school board must require all district schools to devote time on Veterans' Day to an observance that conveys the meaning and significance of that day. This observance must be at least one hour long, except in schools that schedule class periods of less than an hour. In those schools, the observance must be at least one standard class period in length. The district board is to determine the specific activities that constitute the observance in each school after consulting with the school's administrators.

If school is not scheduled to be in session on Veterans' Day, the observance is to be held on the school day immediately preceding Veterans' Day. (Sec. 3313.602.)
