**BILL SUMMARY**

- Prohibits a political subdivision from requiring its employees to reside in any specific area of this state.

---

**CONTENT AND OPERATION**

The bill enacts a general provision prohibiting a political subdivision from requiring its employees, as a condition of employment, to reside in any specific area of this state. The bill defines "political subdivision" as a county, municipal corporation (see **COMMENT**), school district, township, or other body corporate and politic responsible for governmental activities only in a geographic area smaller than that of the state. (Sec. 3.19.)

**COMMENT**

As applied to a municipal corporation, the bill's prohibition may violate the municipal corporation's authority to exercise its powers of local self-government authorized by Section 3 of Article XVIII of the Ohio Constitution.
