BILL SUMMARY

- Creates a special joint legislative committee to review Ohio's tax laws and to cause tax reform legislation to be drafted by December 31, 2001.

CONTENT AND OPERATION

Joint legislative tax review committee

The bill creates the Joint Legislative Committee on Tax Reform. The function of the committee is to review Ohio's tax laws and any reports on Ohio taxes or tax reform that have been commissioned since 1990. The committee is required to provide for tax reform legislation to be drafted by December 31, 2001.

The committee is to consist of eight members: four from the House of Representatives appointed by the House Speaker, and four from the Senate appointed by the Senate President. No more than two of the members appointed from each house may be members of the same political party. The chairperson of the committee is to be appointed jointly by the Speaker and the President.

The committee ceases to exist after December 31, 2001.
