**RESOLUTION SUMMARY**

- Memorializes the United States Postal Service to issue a postage stamp commemorating the Centennial of the Veterans of Foreign Wars.

---

**CONTENT AND OPERATION**

**Postage stamp commemorating the Centennial of the Veterans of Foreign Wars**

This resolution requests that the United States Postal Service issue a postage stamp commemorating the Centennial of the Veterans of Foreign Wars. This resolution recognizes efforts of the Veterans of Foreign Wars for their "willingness to fight, and even to die, for our country's democratic ideals" and, on the occasion of the Veterans of Foreign Wars Centennial, finds it "timely and appropriate" to recognize the members of the Veterans of Foreign Wars "for their selflessness and commitment." The resolution notes that the Veterans of Foreign Service was formed on September 29, 1899, by 13 young Ohio veterans who met to form a group to help veterans and their families. In 1914, similar organizations in Colorado and Pennsylvania met with the Ohio veterans and joined together to form the Veterans of Foreign Wars. The resolution further notes that the Veterans of Foreign Wars has worked diligently to perpetuate and preserve the heroic traditions of our armed forces, earning the respect and gratitude of the veterans and families it has served.

Upon enactment, the resolution requires the Legislative Clerk of the House of Representatives to transmit duly authenticated copies of the resolution to the United States Postal Service and to the Veterans of Foreign Wars, Department of Ohio.
