BILL SUMMARY

- Authorizes townships to regulate the resale of tickets to theatrical, sporting, or other public amusements.

CONTENT AND OPERATION

The bill authorizes a board of township trustees to adopt a resolution to regulate in the unincorporated area of the township, by license or otherwise, the resale, by parties not acting as agents of those issuing them, of tickets to theatrical or sporting events or to other public amusements. The bill allows the board to establish a fine of no more than \$100 for each separate violation of any such resolution. Collected fine moneys must be deposited in the township's general fund. (Sec. 505.95(A) and (B).)

The bill states that any person allegedly aggrieved by a violation of a resolution adopted under the bill may seek injunctive or other appropriate relief in connection with the act or practice that violates the resolution. (Sec. 505.95(C).)
