BILL SUMMARY

- Removes the prohibition against an employee or officer of a public or private college, university, or other institution of higher education from serving on the State Board of Education.

CONTENT AND OPERATION

Current law prohibits persons serving on the State Board of Education from holding "any other public position of trust or profit" or being an "employee or officer of any public or private school, or a public or private college, university, or other institution of higher education."

The bill eliminates the prohibition against an employee of a "public or private college, university, or other institution of higher education" serving on the State Board of Education and amends the current prohibition to clarify that an employee or officer of any public or private *elementary* or *secondary* school is prohibited from serving.
