BILL SUMMARY

- Authorizes the conveyance of state-owned real estate in Cuyahoga County to the Village of Chagrin Falls.

CONTENT AND OPERATION

Operation of the bill

The bill authorizes the Governor to execute a deed in the name of the state conveying to the Village of Chagrin Falls and its successors and assigns all of the state's right, title, and interest in two parcels of state-owned real estate in Cuyahoga County (Section 1).

The consideration for the conveyance is the purchase price of \$20,000 (Section 2).

The bill specifies the procedures for the preparation, execution, and recording of a deed to the real estate (Section 3).

The Village of Chagrin Falls must pay the costs of the conveyance (Section 4).

The bill expires one year after its effective date (Section 5).
