**BILL SUMMARY**

- Authorizes the transfer from the Ohio Department of Transportation to the City of Cincinnati of jurisdiction over all real estate located in Hamilton County that was purchased by the state of Ohio in conjunction with the Colerain Connector Project.

---

**CONTENT AND OPERATION**

The bill states that "(U)pon finalization of the dejournalization process as established by the Ohio Department of Transportation, jurisdiction, including all control and supervision, over all real estate purchased by the State of Ohio in conjunction with the Colerain Connector Project, otherwise known as HAM-127-5,47, is hereby transferred from the Ohio Department of Transportation to the City of Cincinnati" (Section 1).

The bill directs the City of Cincinnati to use the real estate described in Section 1 of the bill for a public purpose. If the City of Cincinnati ceases to use the real estate for a public purpose, all right, title, and interest in the real estate immediately reverts to the Ohio Department of Transportation without need for further action by the Ohio Department of Transportation. (Section 2.)
