**BILL SUMMARY**

- Designates the Blaine Hill Bridge in Belmont County the state's Bicentennial Bridge.

---

**CONTENT AND OPERATION**

The bill designates the Blaine Hill Bridge in Belmont County as Ohio's "Bicentennial Bridge." In making the designation, the bill notes that the Blaine Hill Bridge was constructed in 1828 as part of the National Road (United States Route 40) and is the oldest bridge in the state. (Sec. 5.072.)
