**BILL SUMMARY**

- Approves proposed rule 3301-35-09 of the Administrative Code, regarding school district contracts for academic remediation and intervention services, as approved the State Board of Education on May 12, 1998.

---

**CONTENT AND OPERATION**

**Background**

The Department of Education is required by section 3313.6010 of the Revised Code to recommend rules to the General Assembly "permitting school districts to contract with public and private providers of academic remediation and intervention in mathematics, science, reading, writing, and social studies for the purpose of assisting pupils in grades one through six outside of regular school hours." These rules must be recommended by the Department of Education and approved by joint resolution of the General Assembly. Proposed rule 3301-35-09 is the State Board's recommendation. The State Board conducted a public hearing on April 13, 1998 and on May 12, 1998 approved the proposed rule. S.J.R. 10, if adopted, gives the General Assembly's approval of proposed rule 3301-35-09.

**Proposed rule 3301-35-09: contracts for academic remediation and intervention**

The rule simply duplicates the language of the statute. It permits school districts to "contract with public and private providers of academic remediation
