**ACT SUMMARY**

- Designates the viaduct spanning the Ashtabula River that is located in the city of Ashtabula and Ashtabula Township and is part of United States Route 20, the "Reverend Dr. Sam Wells, Jr., Memorial Viaduct" and permits the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers on the viaduct indicating its name (sec. 5533.55).
- Designates the bridge spanning the Paddy Creek near the village of Proctorville in Lawrence County that is part of State Route 7 the "Judge Kenneth B. Ater Bridge" and permits the Director to erect suitable markers on the bridge or its approaches indicating its name (sec. 5533.57).

**COMMENT**

Reverend Dr. Sam Wells, Jr. was pastor of the Peoples Baptist Church, which is located in the city of Ashtabula.

Judge Kenneth B. Ater was a judge for 30 years and, at the time of his retirement, was the Presiding Judge of Lawrence County Common Pleas Court.
