**ACT SUMMARY**

- Designates a portion of State Route 72, from its intersection with Interstate 70 in Clark County to the boundary of Clark and Champaign Counties, as the "Governor James A. Rhodes Memorial Highway."
- Authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the highway indicating its name.

**COMMENT**

James A. Rhodes served four terms in office as Ohio's governor, being elected in 1962, 1966, 1974, and 1978.
