BILL SUMMARY

- Designates State Route 2, running in an easterly and westerly direction, commencing at the approach of the "Thomas A. Edison Memorial Bridge" and extending through Erie County only, the "Jackie Mayer Miss America Highway."
- Permits the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the highway indicating its name.

COMMENT

Jacquelyn Mayer was selected Miss Ohio in 1962 and Miss America in 1963.
