**BILL SUMMARY**

- Designates State Route 7 from the intersection of that highway and Rush Run Road in Jefferson County to the boundary of Jefferson and Belmont Counties as the "Bill Mazeroski Highway."
- Permits the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the highway indicating its name.

Bill Mazeroski, who grew up in the Ohio River Valley in Jefferson County, played second base for the Pittsburgh Pirates baseball club for 17 years. He was inducted into the National Baseball Hall of Fame on August 5, 2001.
