BILL SUMMARY

- Provides that the deputy registrar service fee for issuing a duplicate or replacement identification card is \$2.75, rather than \$3.75, beginning July 1, 2001.
- Declares an emergency.

CONTENT AND OPERATION

The Conference Committee report for Am. Sub. H.B. 94 of the 124th General Assembly provided that the service fee deputy registrars charge for issuing a duplicate or replacement identification card be \$2.75 beginning July 1, 2001.^{1,2} But the version of the bill that became law set the fee at \$3.75 beginning on that date.

The bill corrects the error, providing that the deputy registrar's service fee for issuing a duplicate or replacement identification card is \$2.75 beginning July 1, 2001.

¹ *The Conference Committee report also set most of the other service fees charged by deputy registrars at \$2.75 beginning July 1, 2001. The service fee under prior law was \$2.25.*

² *A duplicate identification card is obtained if the original card is lost, destroyed, or mutilated, while a replacement card is obtained if the cardholder's name changes.*
