BILL SUMMARY

- Designates State Route 571, running in an easterly and westerly direction within Miami County only, the "Robert E. Netzley Highway."
- Permits the Director of Transportation to erect markers along the highway indicating its name, provided sufficient private contributions are received by the Department of Transportation to pay all costs associated with the markers.
- Prohibits public money from being used to pay the costs associated with the "Robert E. Netzley Highway" markers.

CONTENT AND OPERATION

The bill designates State Route number 571, running in an easterly and westerly direction, through Miami County only, the "Robert E. Netzley Highway." It also authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the highway indicating its name, provided the Department of Transportation (ODOT)

has received private contributions sufficient to pay all costs of manufacturing, erecting, and maintaining the markers. Any private money received by ODOT for "Robert E. Netzley Highway" markers must be deposited in the state treasury to the credit of the State Highway Operating Fund or any other departmental fund determined by the Director. The bill specifies that no public money may be used to pay the costs associated with "Robert E. Netzley Highway" markers.

COMMENT

Robert Netzley served in the Ohio House of Representatives continuously from 1961 until 2000.
