BILL SUMMARY

- Authorizes a board of township trustees, by unanimous vote, to appropriate money to a municipal corporation to be used for municipal public purposes that also benefit the health, safety, or welfare of citizens of the township.

CONTENT AND OPERATION

The bill authorizes a board of township trustees to appropriate money to a municipal corporation to be used for municipal public purposes that also benefit the health, safety, or welfare of citizens of the township. All or part of the municipal corporation must be within the boundaries of the township. The money must be from the township's general fund, and cannot be otherwise encumbered. The board's resolution making the appropriation must be adopted by a unanimous vote, and must specify the public purposes on which the municipal corporation can expend the money.
