CORRECTIONS TO THE ORIGINAL DOCUMENT:

In the **BILL SUMMARY**, on page 12, the provision related to the delayed effective date should read as follows:

Delayed effective date

- Provides that the operative provisions of the bill, other than those described above on page 9 regarding limited driving privileges for juveniles whose driver's license or permit has been suspended, take effect on January 1, 2004.

In the **CONTENT AND OPERATION** section, on page 62, the provision related to the delayed effective date should read as follows:

Delayed effective date

The bill provides that the operative provisions of the bill, other than those described above in "**Limited driving privileges--suspension of a juvenile's license**," take effect January 1, 2004 (Section 4 of the bill). The limited driving privilege provisions have a regular 90-day effective date, and remain in effect until January 1, 2004 (Sections 6 to 8 of the bill).
