BILL SUMMARY

- Designates Interstate 490, running in a westerly and easterly direction within the municipal corporation of Cleveland between the intersections of that highway and Interstate Highways 71 and 90 in the west and Interstate 77 in the east, the "Troy Lee James Highway."
- Permits the Director of Transportation to erect markers along the highway indicating the name.

Troy Lee James served in the Ohio House of Representatives continuously from 1967 until 2000.
