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**BILL SUMMARY**

- Designates the continuous portion of State Route 49, running in a northerly and then northwesterly direction, located within the municipal corporation of Trotwood and extending into the municipal corporation of Clayton, the "Joseph Guy LaPointe, Jr. Memorial Parkway."
- Permits the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers upon the highway indicating its name.

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**COMMENT**

Specialist Fourth Class Joseph Guy LaPointe, Jr., was killed in action during the Vietnam War and was a posthumous recipient of the Medal of Honor.
