BILL SUMMARY

- Designates the portion of State Route 7, commencing at the boundary of Columbiana and Jefferson Counties and extending in a northeasterly direction through the municipal corporation of Wellsville to the westernmost boundary of the municipal corporation of East Liverpool, as the "Melvin E. Newlin Memorial Highway."
- Permits the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the highway indicating its name.

COMMENT

Melvin E. Newlin of Wellsville, Ohio received the Congressional Medal of Honor posthumously for service in the Marine Corps in Vietnam.
