**BILL SUMMARY**

- Designates a portion of United States Route 68, from its intersection with Interstate 70 in Clark County to the boundary of Clark and Champaign counties, as the "Governor James A. Rhodes Memorial Highway."
- Authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the highway indicating its name.

James A. Rhodes served four terms in office as Ohio's governor, being elected in 1962, 1966, 1974, and 1978.
