**BILL SUMMARY**

? Designates a portion of Interstate 71 within Ashland County as the "Trooper James R. Gross Memorial Highway."

---

**CONTENT AND OPERATION**

Current law designates Interstate 71, throughout the entire state, as the "Disabled American Veterans' Highway." In addition to this current designation, the bill designates a two-mile portion of Interstate 71 within Ashland County as the "Trooper James R. Gross Memorial Highway." The bill also authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the highway indicating its name. (Sec. 5533.33.)

**COMMENT**

Trooper Gross of the Ashland post of the State Highway Patrol was murdered on January 19, 1996 during a traffic stop on Interstate 71 in Ashland County.
