BILL SUMMARY

- Increases the threshold amount that requires Ohio Turnpike Commission contracts to be competitively bid from \$10,000 to \$50,000.

CONTENT AND OPERATION

Under current law, when an Ohio Turnpike Commission contract exceeds \$10,000, the Commission must use competitive bidding and then must make a written contract with the lowest responsive and responsible bidder in accordance with general standards established for state agencies and political subdivisions. Contracts with governmental agencies, for the acquisition of real property, and to pay for professional or other personal services are excluded from the competitive bidding requirements.

The bill increases the competitive bidding threshold from \$10,000 to \$50,000. This threshold last was increased in 1991, from \$5,000 to the current level of \$10,000.
