BILL SUMMARY

- Requires the establishment of toll-free telephone access to the offices of General Assembly members.

CONTENT AND OPERATION

The bill requires the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives to provide the public with toll-free telephone access to each house's respective members. The access must be provided either (1) directly to a member's State Capital office by way of a toll-free telephone number assigned to that office or (2) through a central toll-free telephone number from which a caller may be transferred to a member's State Capital office. (Sec. 101.18.)
