**BILL SUMMARY**

- Permits a township to obtain individual life insurance coverage for township officers and full-time employees.

---

**CONTENT AND OPERATION**

Current law permits a board of township trustees to procure and pay all or any part of the cost of group life insurance to insure the lives of township officers and full-time employees. Group life insurance for township officers cannot exceed \$50,000 per officer.

The bill permits a board of township trustees to procure and pay for individual life insurance policies to insure the lives of township officers and full-time employees. The benefits from either a group or individual life insurance policy must be made payable to beneficiaries named by the officers and employees or, when there is no named beneficiary, to the estate of the insured officer or employee.
