BILL SUMMARY

- Prohibits any person from including an individual's Social Security number on any document submitted to the county recorder for recording unless that number is otherwise required by law to be on the document (R.C. 317.082, first sentence).
- Provides an affirmative defense that a person may raise in a civil action for damages for any harm an individual allegedly sustains as a result of the inclusion of an individual's Social Security number on a document in violation of the bill's noninclusion requirement: namely, that the person made a good faith effort to comply with the requirement (R.C. 317.082, second sentence).
