BILL SUMMARY

- Designates a portion of State Route 315 within Franklin County the "Lawrence E. Hughes Memorial Highway" and permits the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the highway indicating its name and to accept private contributions to pay all or part of the markers.
- Designates a portion of United States Route 250 as the "Bill Hinig Memorial Highway" and permits the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the highway indicating its name.

CONTENT AND OPERATION

The bill designates the portion of State Route 315 within Franklin County, from King Avenue northward to the boundary of Franklin County and Delaware County, the "Lawrence E. Hughes Memorial Highway." The Director of Transportation is permitted to erect suitable markers along the highway indicating its name. The Director also may accept private contributions to pay all or part of the costs of manufacturing, erecting, and maintaining the markers. Any such private money the Department of Transportation receives must be deposited in the

state treasury to the credit of the State Highway Operating Fund or any other ODOT fund as determined by the Director.

The bill also designates a portion of United States Route 250, commencing at Interstate Route 77 and extending in southeasterly direction through the municipal corporation of Uhrichsville, as the "Bill Hinig Memorial Highway." The Director of Transportation is permitted to erect suitable markers along the highway indicating its name.

Bill Hinig served in the Ohio House of Representatives from 1965 to 1989.
