BILL SUMMARY

- Designates the portion of United States Route 35 located within Gallia County only, running in an easterly and westerly direction, the "Bob Evans Highway."
- Permits the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the highway indicating its name.

Bob Evans served on the Ohio Board of Regents, has supported organizations such as 4-H, the Future Farmers of America, the Heart Fund, and Easter Seals, and founded the restaurant chain and retail foods company that bear his name.
