BILL SUMMARY

- Requires that the General Assembly's web site contain information about how each member votes on bills and resolutions.

CONTENT AND OPERATION

The bill requires the General Assembly to establish and maintain on its Internet web site the following information regarding the votes of members on the final passage of bills or resolutions brought up for third consideration in both houses, as reported in the Senate and House of Representatives journals (R.C. 101.60):

- The title of each bill or resolution brought up for third consideration and voted upon.
- A brief description of the content of that bill or resolution.
- The name of each member and an indication of that member's vote, or that the member failed to vote, on the final passage of the bill or resolution.
