**BILL SUMMARY**

- Requires the Director of Commerce to use a sufficient portion of the Department's fiscal years 2006 and 2007 appropriations to hire staff to enforce Ohio's consumer protection laws governing consumer credit mortgage loan transactions.

---

**CONTENT AND OPERATION**

The bill amends section 203.75 of the recently enacted main operating budget for the state for fiscal years 2006 and 2007 (Am. Sub. H.B. 66 of the 126th General Assembly). That section, among other appropriations to the Department of Commerce, appropriates \$4,300,445 in each fiscal year to appropriation item 800-607, Consumer Finance. The bill requires that the Director of Commerce use a sufficient amount of the appropriation to hire staff for the enforcement of Ohio's consumer protection laws governing consumer credit mortgage loan transactions.<sup>1</sup>
