BILL SUMMARY

- Creates the Commemorative Ohio National Guard Service Medal to be awarded to retired members of the Ohio National Guard.

CONTENT AND OPERATION

The bill creates the Commemorative Ohio National Guard Service Medal and requires the Adjutant General to design the Medal and administer the program for its distribution. Retired members of the Ohio National Guard who have been honorably or medically discharged or released from service in the Ohio National Guard are eligible, upon application, to receive the medal. Those retired members must submit a copy of their DD-214 form to the Adjutant General when applying to receive the medal.¹ (R.C. 5919.19.)
