BILL SUMMARY

- Designates each April 29 as "Dale Earnhardt Day."

CONTENT AND OPERATION

The bill designates each April 29 as "Dale Earnhardt Day" in honor of Dale Earnhardt who was born on that day in 1951. The designation is stated to be for his (1) passion for NASCAR racing (see **COMMENT**), (2) devotion to family and friends, and (3) countless contributions to the racing industry in Ohio and throughout the United States. (R.C. 5.2235.)

COMMENT

"NASCAR" is the acronym for the National Association for Stock Car Auto Racing, an organization that was founded in February 1948 in Daytona Beach, Florida, and that functions as the governing body for stock car auto racing.
