BILL SUMMARY

- Permits the Director of Public Safety to authorize public entities such as vocational schools and community colleges to offer motorcycle operation instruction courses without fee restrictions, and provides that such entities are not eligible to be reimbursed from the Motorcycle Safety and Education Fund for their expenses or subsidies.

CONTENT AND OPERATION

The Motorcycle Safety and Education Program of the Department of Public Safety

The Department of Public Safety is in charge of the state motorcycle safety and education program. The program includes approved courses of instruction that are taught by certified instructors and are conducted at vocational schools, community colleges, and other suitable locations. A reasonable tuition fee, as determined by the Director of Public Safety, may be charged. The Director may authorize private organizations or corporations to offer courses without tuition fee restrictions, but these entities are not eligible to be reimbursed from the state Motorcycle Safety and Education Fund for their expenses or subsidies. (R.C. 4508.08.)

The bill permits the Director to authorize public entities such as vocational schools and community colleges as well, to offer instruction courses without fee restrictions. As with private organizations and corporations that offer the courses, any such public entity that offers the courses is not eligible to be reimbursed from the Motorcycle Safety and Education Fund for its expenses or subsidies.
