**CONTENT AND OPERATION**

The bill adopts the children's book *Lentil* as the official children's book of Ohio and designates its author, Robert McCloskey, who was born in Hamilton, Ohio, as the official children's book author of Ohio (R.C. 5.091).

*Lentil*, published in 1940, is about Lentil, a fictional boy about ten or 11 years old, who lives in a typical Midwestern town, the fictional Alto, Ohio.
