**BILL SUMMARY**

- Designates the portion of State Route 2 within the city of Willoughby only, as the "Brian Montgomery Memorial Highway."
- Designates a portion of State Route 44 within Lake County as the "Andy Nowacki Memorial Highway."
- Permits the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along each highway indicating its designated name.

---

**CONTENT AND OPERATION**

The bill designates State Route 2, within the municipal corporation of Willoughby only, as the "Brian Montgomery Memorial Highway." (R.C. 5533.632; **COMMENT 1**.)

The bill also designates the part of State Route 44 located within Lake County, from the intersection of State Route 44 and State Route 2 extending to Headlands Beach State Park, as the "Andy Nowacki Memorial Highway." (R.C. 5533.91; **COMMENT 2**.)

For both designated highways, the bill permits the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the highway indicating its name.

**COMMENT**

1. Brian Montgomery, a lance corporal in the United States Marine Corps, was killed in Iraq on August, 1, 2005.

2. Andy Nowacki, a Grand River police officer and a lance corporal in the United States Marine Corps, was killed in Iraq on February 26, 2005.
