BILL SUMMARY

- Repeals the prohibition against and eliminates the penalty for hunting, shooting, or killing game within one-half mile of a township park.

CONTENT AND OPERATION

Hunting near township park

(Repeal of R.C. 3773.06; R.C. 3773.99)

Current law prohibits a person from hunting, shooting, or killing game within one-half mile of a township park, but the board of township park commissioners may grant permission to kill game not desired that is within those limits. Any person who violates this law is guilty of a fourth degree misdemeanor.

The bill repeals the prohibition against, and eliminates the penalty for, hunting, shooting, or killing game within one-half mile of a township park.
