ACT SUMMARY

- Designates the bridge that will span the Cuyahoga River in Cuyahoga County and will be part of Interstate 90 (approximate scheduled completion date of late 2016 or early 2017) the "George V. Voinovich Bridge" and authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the bridge or its approaches indicating its name.¹

COMMENT

George V. Voinovich served as a member of the Ohio House of Representatives from 1967 to 1971, Mayor of Cleveland from 1979 to 1989, Governor of Ohio from 1991 to 1998, and United States Senator from 1999 to 2011.
