ACT SUMMARY

- Designates February 20 as "John Glenn Friendship 7 Day."

CONTENT AND OPERATION

The act designates the twentieth day of February as "John Glenn Friendship 7 Day" in honor of John Glenn's participation in the first orbital space mission of the United States on February 20, 1962.¹ The act is an emergency measure, which means it will take immediate effect.
