ACT SUMMARY

- Designates the third week of July as "Ohio Aggregates and Industrial Minerals Awareness Week."

CONTENT AND OPERATION

The act designates the third week of July as "Ohio Aggregates and Industrial Minerals Awareness Week" in order to educate the public about, increase public awareness of, and recognize both of the following:

- (1) The important contributions of Ohio's aggregates and industrial minerals industry to construction and transportation and to Ohio's economic viability; and
- (2) The industry's environmentally responsible stewardship of Ohio's resources.¹
