ACT SUMMARY

- Increases the maximum distance that school board-owned motor vehicles may travel on out-of-state trips from 240 miles to 1,000 miles.

CONTENT AND OPERATION

The act raises, from 240 miles to 1,000 miles, the maximum distance that a motor vehicle owned or operated by a school district board of education may transport students on out-of-state trips. The entire distance traveled outside the state cannot exceed 1,000 miles round-trip.¹
