BILL SUMMARY

- Designates Interstate Route 75 running through the counties of Lucas, Wood, Hancock, Allen, Auglaize, Shelby, Miami, Montgomery, Warren, Butler, and Hamilton as the "Tuskegee Airmen Memorial Trail" and permits the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers upon the designated portion of the highway indicating its name.¹

COMMENT

Interstate Route 75 currently carries the designations "American Legion Memorial Highway" and "Pearl Harbor Memorial Highway."²
