BILL SUMMARY

- Designates the portion of United States Route 50, commencing at mile marker 12 and proceeding in an easterly direction to mile marker 24 within Highland County only, as the "Pfc. Zachary Gullett Memorial Highway" and authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the highway indicating its name.¹

COMMENT

Pfc. Zachary Gullett died in Iraq on May 1, 2007, after collapsing during calisthenics.

The portion of United States Route 50 that is the subject of the bill currently carries the designation "George Washington Highway."²
