BILL SUMMARY

- Permits motorcycle handlebars to be of any height so long as the handlebars do not rise higher than the shoulders of the operator when the operator is seated in the operator's seat or saddle.

CONTENT AND OPERATION

Height of motorcycle handlebars

The bill permits motorcycle handlebars to be of any height so long as the handlebars do not rise higher than the shoulders of the operator when the operator is seated in the operator's seat or saddle.¹ Current law prohibits any motorcycle from being operated on a highway when the handlebars or grips are more than 15 inches higher than the operator's seat or saddle.
