BILL SUMMARY

- Adopts the Adena Pipe as the official artifact of Ohio.

CONTENT AND OPERATION

Adena Pipe

The bill adopts, as the official state artifact, the artifact known as the Adena Pipe, which is a prehistoric effigy pipe that was discovered in 1901 by William C. Mills within a burial mound near Chillicothe, and that was created by the ancient Adena culture (800 B.C. to A.D. 1)¹ from native Ohio pipestone.²
