BILL SUMMARY

- Designates a portion of the road known as United States Route 322 within the municipal corporation of Cleveland Heights, running in an easterly and westerly direction between the intersection of that road and Coventry Road and the intersection of that road and Warrensville Center Road, as the "Officer Thomas F. Patton II Memorial Highway," and authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the road indicating its name.¹

Officer Thomas F. Patton II died March 13, 2010, in the line of duty.
