BILL SUMMARY

- Designates February 20 as "John Glenn Friendship 7 Day."
- Declares an emergency.

CONTENT AND OPERATION

The bill designates the twentieth day of February as "John Glenn Friendship 7 Day" in honor of John Glenn's participation in the first orbital space mission of the United States on February 20, 1962. The bill declares it is an emergency measure, which means it will take immediate effect.
