BILL SUMMARY

- Designates the bridge spanning the Vermillion River that is part of State Route 113 and is located in the community of Birmingham in Erie County, as the "Staff Sgt. James P. Hunter Memorial Bridge" and authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers upon the bridge or its approaches indicating its name.¹

COMMENT

Staff Sgt. James P. Hunter, an Army journalist, died in Afghanistan on June 18, 2010 of injuries sustained when insurgents attacked his unit with an improvised explosive device.
